## ***VETERAN’S FIELD UPDATE***

Week Ending July 22

- Site sub-grading completed with exception of areas in southeasterly portion of site.
- All line, end, and corner fence posts for synthetic turf installed (not backstops).
- Perimeter curbing forming and pouring began this week, ongoing today.
- Drainage trunk lines, structures, stone backfill installed for perimeter limits of multi sports field.
- Continuing trunk line installation.
- Survey layout for site ongoing.
- Precast deliveries for site drainage structures received this week.
- Stockpiling of historic fill and clean DGA is ongoing
- Pole removals for site are being coordinated with PSEG.
- Water service application is being prepared.
- Shop drawing submittals ongoing.
- Field turf rep. on site 7/21 and confirmed turf will be ready for installation per schedule.

Week Ending July 29

- Continue trunk line drain pipes and structures for turf fields.
- Continue perimeter curb for turf fields.
- Contractor to do subgrade touch ups and survey for turf fields.
- Begin subgrade fabric and drains for turf fields.
- Begin installation of stone base for turf fields.
- Site curb and sidewalk pours.
